The District's NEW MATH doesn't add up!

The state is providing \$47 million in **new revenues** to the district in 2018-19. After the levy swap the district will net \$35 million in 2018-19. In developing the budget for the district, it appears that their math reveals only \$14 million in "permanent revenues" available for salaries. Besides insisting on paying back the ending fund balance \$2.8 million despite the balance growing beyond the budget, they also subtract the levy loss for 2018-19 AND frontload the levy loss for 2019-2020 without addressing additional new appropriations for the second year. The district still contends it cannot exceed the 3.1% cap that no longer exists because it is fully funded and no longer a "transitional" year. It just doesn't add up!

Other settlements around the state: Bellevue 19.4% (Min \$53k, Max \$111k), Bainbridge Island 21.1% (Min \$54k, Max \$105k), Othello 17.2% (Min \$51k, Max \$95k).
