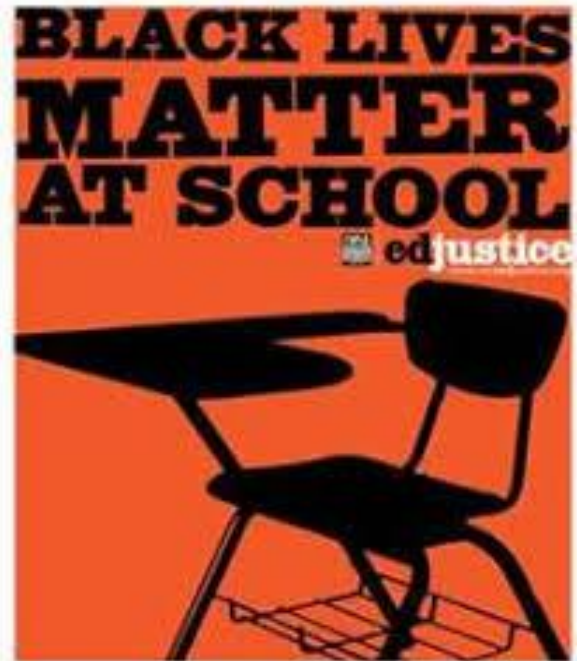
Safety and Social Distancing
