## 2023 VEA Interim Bargaining Team in Action

Thank you to all of the members who completed the Interim Bargaining Survey. Your input is the driving force behind the work of your VEA Bargaining team! Bargaining Chair, Jamie Anderson met with VEA President Kari Van Nostran and Interim Executive Director Phil Harding on March 8<sup>th</sup> to read every comment from the all-member survey as preliminary work for the VEA Team, who then met together on March 15<sup>th</sup> to narrow the focus down to the top three non-monetary priorities for this bargain: Evaluation/Chapter 8, PLC's/Chapter 12, and adjusting workload expectations for special educators and ESAs. Additionally, the Washington Senate budget was just released and the VEA Team is watching legislative actions closely as they contemplate proposals for Article 11.3 and a 2023-24 Cost of Living Adjustment (COLA).

VEA is an active participant in coordinated bargaining discussions for SW Washington. Together, we learn more about contract language, focus on various topics of interest, and learn where our neighboring education associations are focused for their current/future bargains. This collaboration strengthens our VEA work at the bargaining table!



WEA supports these sessions with staff who specialize in specific areas of focus. Leaders and staff from locals in our area met on February 28<sup>th</sup> to look at contract comparisons and approaches to launching the new TPEP student growth goals. Maximizing WEA research tools and receiving updates on Special Education are topics scheduled for a March 28<sup>th</sup> meeting. Finally, the group will reconvene on May 3<sup>rd</sup> to understand and discuss the Washington Legislative Session outcomes.
