Issue 6 – 2023 Interim Bargain



Yesterday, May 17<sup>th</sup>, our VEA Bargaining team came back together with the VPS team to further negotiations. VEA received a VPS counter to our original salary proposal, which included a percentage increase over the 3.7% IPD, which we believe is insufficient to help us close the regional pay gap and to help make VPS salary more competitive with other local school districts. VEA leadership will now conduct a deeper dive into VPS budget data in preparation for a counterproposal of our own.

## Another round complete, preparing for the next!

Your VEA team provided responses to VPS counterproposals surrounding Special Education Teacher/ESA Exemptions and PLCs/Guiding Coalitions. We also received a VPS counterproposal to the topic of Educator Evaluations and prepared a draft counter of our own to share next week. While the table exchange with VPS remains collaborative and congenial, the VEA and VPS bargaining teams still have differing positions per topic to talk and work through. As we proceed, your VEA team is grateful for the member stories and scenarios you've shared in VEA bargaining surveys to ensure we are reflecting member reality on your behalf!
